

Prescription Collection/delivery:

People who are clinically extremely vulnerable (CEV) have been advised by the Government not to go to a pharmacy ([CEV Letter](#)). This means that all pharmacies and dispensing doctors in England will be required to ensure patients those on the clinically extremely vulnerable (Shielded) Patient List receive their medicines at home. People who are clinically extremely vulnerable (CEV) should contact their pharmacy. If an individual cannot undertake their own medication collection, alternative services can be found in the table below.
